We are the British Paralympic Association (BPA), and we are the National Paralympic Committee for Great Britain. It is our responsibility to select, prepare, enter and manage the team for Great Britain and Northern Ireland at the Paralympic Games. This team is known as ParalympicsGB.

All athletes that are part of ParalympicsGB must go through Classification to understand the impact their impairment has on performance in their chosen sport, and to put them into the appropriate Sport Class. National classification is required for entry into National-level competitions, with International classification needed when competing at the International level.

The BPA coordinate opportunities for National classification for athletes with a Visual Impairment. We are searching for more individuals who would be interested in acting as a National Classifier for Visual Impairment.
